Day 1: Nairobi - Masai Mara National Reserve (5 to 6 hours)

Buffalo herds and zebras are just the beginning—depending on the season, you may also witness the Great Migration from June to October, as wildebeests and other animals traverse the expansive grasslands.

Lunch is served in the park near the Mara River, giving you more time to explore and experience the sights of this spectacular landscape. After lunch, consider an optional visit to a Maasai village. The Maasai people, who have lived in harmony with this land for centuries, will greet you with traditional song and dance, providing an intimate cultural experience. This is a rare opportunity to learn about their way of life, visit a home, and gain deeper insight into the rich heritage of the Mara region. The visit costs \$20 per person and offers a truly authentic experience.

As evening approaches, return to your lodge or camp for dinner and a restful night, preparing for more thrilling adventures on your Kenyan safari.

This is an exceptional opportunity to witness the park's wildlife at its most active.

Afterward, return to your accommodation for breakfast, then embark on your journey to Amboseli National Park. The drive offers stunning vistas of the Great African Rift Valley, with majestic mountains, deep valleys, and local villages dotting the landscape. As you make your way through the heart of Kenya, you'll be enveloped by the natural beauty that defines the country.

Lunch is served along the way, and upon arrival in Amboseli, you'll enjoy a short game drive as you approach your accommodation.
